    - GUI (r-core)
    - Third Party GUIs: ESS, JGR, deducer, etc.
  - RStudio: unified desktop and web server GUI for R - <http://www.rstudio.org>

- What is GitHub

- Git: distributed software revision control system - <http://git-scm.com/>.
- GitHub: web application for storing hosted Git repositories - <http://github.com>.
- Gists: simple way to share snippets of code with others.

- Git Commands

- Init - create a new empty repository
- Clone - make a copy of an existing repository
- Add - add changed files to a commit
- Status - show basic info about a repository
- Log - display commit messages
